Introduction

Martin Luther said, "*This is my beloved Psalm*". 1745 Louis Rank a Huguenot Pastor

We must learn to trust God alone.

repeated refrain *His mercy endures forever.*

verses 5-6, "*The Lord is on my side*"

verse 7

verses 10-11, - Putin and NATO

verses 12 and 13,

verses 8-9,

verse 14,

Spurgeon says - this King is special. "*It is better to trust the Lord*"

verses 14-15

We can be saved by God's King alone.

Who is this King?

verse 22,

"*group think*" reject this King. Iraq war - COVID

David. 1 Chronicles 16:34,

Psalm personifies Israel. Ezra, after a 70 year exile in Babylon. Ezra 3,

Acts 4. From verse 10,

Psalm 118, from verse 17- 20

verse 21

verses 22-23,

1 Peter 2.

Let us praise and thank God alone for His mercy endures forever.

"*day*" can refer to "*an age*"

"*day*" can also literally mean "*a day*".
